# Pockrovsky Cathedral

*Pockrovsky Cathedral is the place, which is well-known to almost each person in Barnaul. It is the biggest and the most attended church in Altay. In 2004 the cathedral celebrated the 100th jubilee.*

*The place for its building was chosen in a poor district of the city. The parishioners were peasants, artisans and very poor people that is why it was decided to open a parish school under the cathedral. It was the first parish school in Barnaul.*



# Alexander-Nevsky Cathedral


*The first stone of this church was put in 1991 by Patriarch of Moscow and All Russia Alexey II. Alexander-Nevsky Cathedral is situated in a very beautiful park zone at the crossing of three city districts.*

# Nickolskaya Church

*This church was built in honour of the most favourite and honorable Saint Nickolas at the beginning of the XX century. At that time there was a rule to build a church in the place where some regiment was stationed. In Barnaul there was a infantry regiment that is why the Military Ministry gave money to build a church and the project was approved by the tsar Nickolas II.*



# Saint Tatyana's Chapel

*The chapel was built in honour of Saint Tatyana who was the patroness of students. The idea of building belonged to the students and the teachers of the Altay Polytechnic University who took an active part in designing of a chapel project.*

*And now young people can come to pray or to get married in the chapel.*
