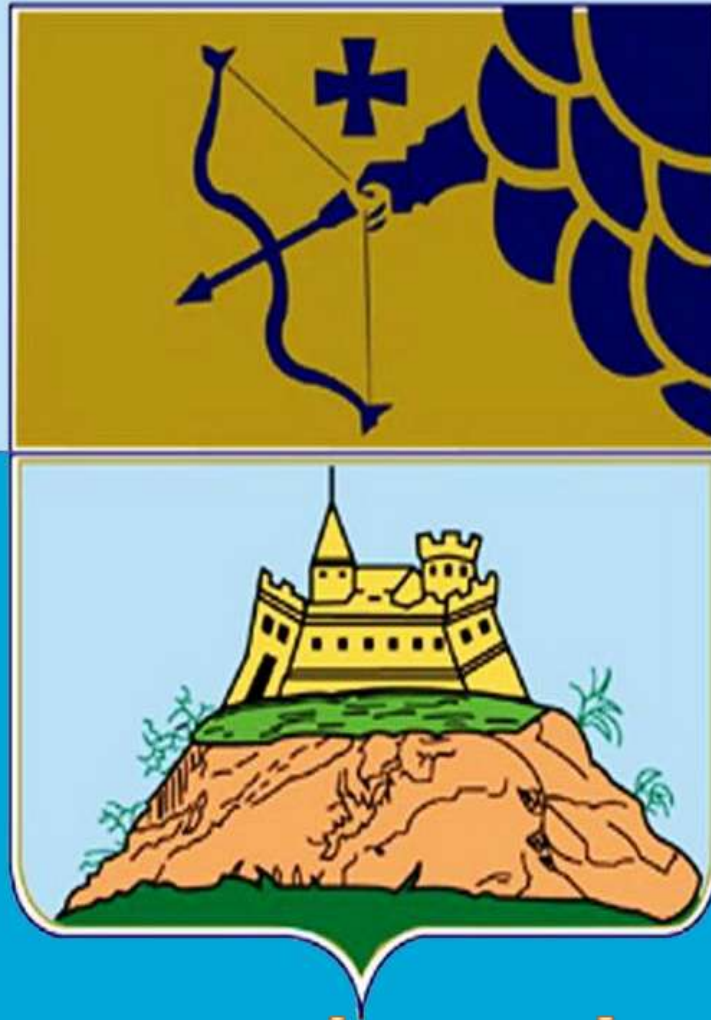

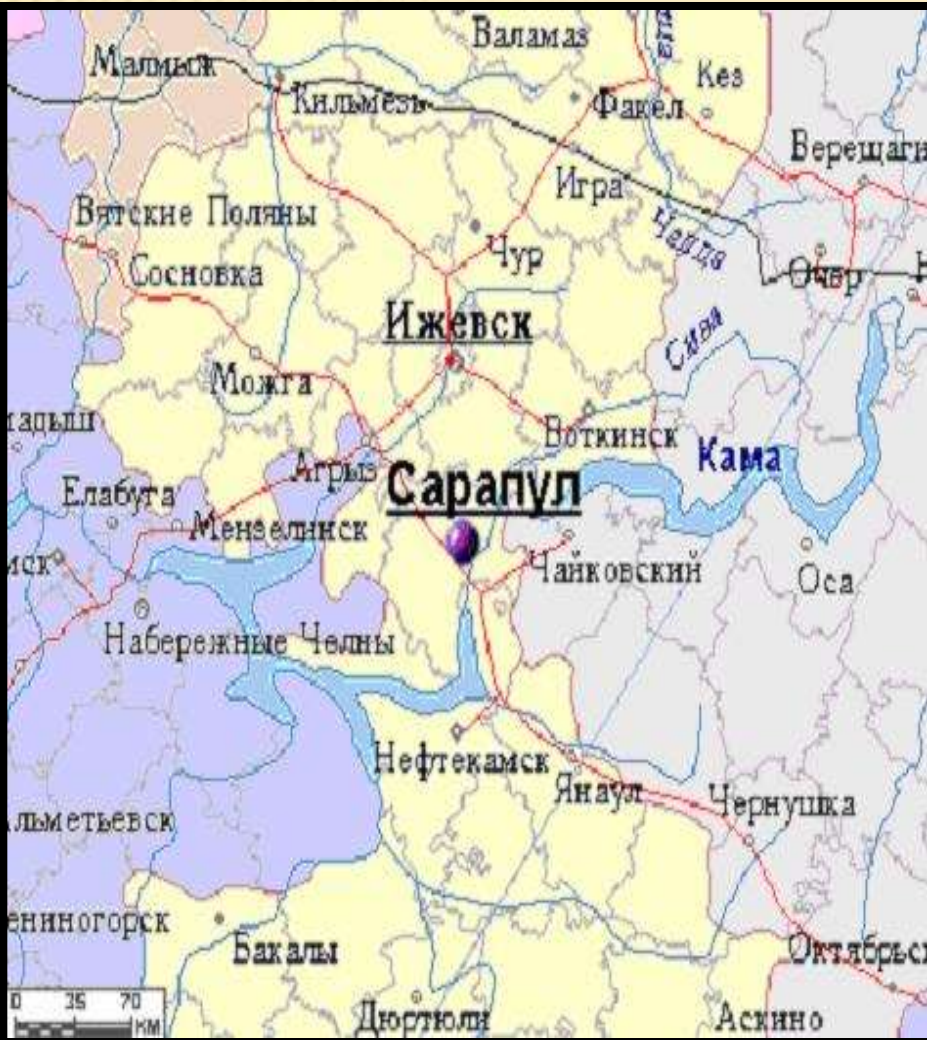


# Memories.

✘ Of course there are a lot of places of interest, such as Memorial and biographical-historical house museum of academician N.V.Melnikova


