# *General information:*

---

- National park "Zyuratkul" was established as a national park on November 3, 1993
  - It is situated in the Satkinsky District and is 215.3 thousand acres in area
  - It contains 15 natural relics, a large variety of flora (650 in all) and also more than 150 birds and 44 mammal species live here.
  - This lake is situated 724 metres above the Baltic Sea level and has a volume of 80 million cubic metres

- In the national park "Zyuratkul" there are so many wonderful places. Come to the park in the winter and you will see a strange sculpture made from blue ice – the ice fountain.

There are more than 650 species (70 of which are very rare). All these species are interesting and beautiful.
