# Our city



- The city was founded in 1893 at the future site of a Trans-Siberian Railway bridge crossing the great Siberian river of Ob.
- It was named Novonikolayevsk, in honor of both Saint Nicholas and the reigning tsar, Nicholas II.
- The importance of the city further increased with the completion of the Turkestan-Siberia Railway in the early 20th century.

# Zoo's history

- Around the middle of 1933, based on a small Novosibirsk's agrobiostation, formed the West-Siberian Edge Children's Technology and Agriculture Station (ECTAS).
- In early 1935 the zoo consisted of a living corner with a small office of Zoology.
- At the zoo worked zoolaboratory.

# Now

- Currently, the Novosibirsk zoo contains about 10 000 individuals and 702 species of animals.
- More than 300 species listed in the International Red Book, Red Book of Russia and Novosibirsk Oblast.
- The Novosibirsk Zoo is one of the best collections in the world of the family cat and marten.



# **RARE ANIMALS OF THE ZOO**

## **RARE ANIMALS: LIGER**

Liger is a hybrid between a lion and a tigress, looks like a very big lion with diffused stripes.



## **RARE ANIMALS: STELLER'S SEA EAGLE**

Distributed on the Kamchatka Peninsula and along the coast of the Okhotsk Sea. Steller's sea eagle - one of the world's most beautiful birds, nests only in our country on the shores of the Far Eastern seas.



## MANUL

Distributed in the Trans-Baikal. A favorite habitat is upland, hilly desert, deserts and steppes to the outputs of stones, situated on the slopes of low mountains.





## **PERSIAN LEOPARD**

Persian leopard -  
one of the most  
rare and  
large leopards.
